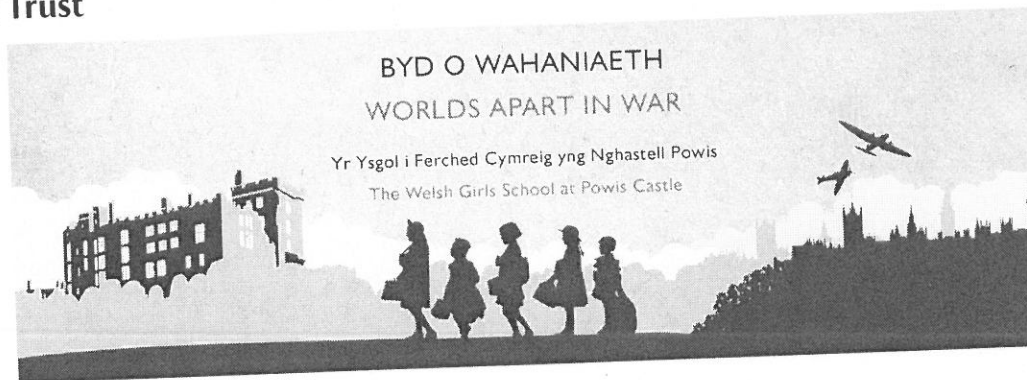

WW2 Evacuee Project

This year Powis Castle and Garden is remembering the Castle during the second world war, when the Welsh Girls School, was evacuated to the Castle for 4 years. Throughout the castle and gardens, we explore what life was like for the girls, and many other evacuees from Birkenhead, Liverpool and London, who were sent to escape the bombing in their home cities and found themselves housed in and around the castle at this time. We have an air raid shelter to hide in, audio clips of local people who were evacuated and stayed, or came back later, and hands on activities to explore what life was like at this time.

As I'm aware that the school's project this term is looking at Evacuees coming to the area in WW2, I enclose 30 family tickets to share with the parents if anyone would like to visit the property.

Over half term we also have autumn and Halloween trails for the younger children, which hopefully they will enjoy.
